

River Region provides housing and support services for adults with HIV/AIDS and co-occurring substance abuse and or mental illness problems, as well as a history of criminal justice involvement. Based upon individual client needs, the HOPWA program consists of housing services that range between supportive mental health and substance abuse services, closely supervised assisted living, and residential co-occurring treatment services. These services are funded in part by the Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Housing Opportunities for Persons Living with AIDS Fund.
